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

## PROJECT AIMS




Gather the voices and experiences of secondary service pupils within the Study Higher region

- For service pupils, by service pupils







#### TRANSPARENCY, AGENCY AND ASSUMPTIONS


- Lack of full knowledge

- Did not use the term 'resilience'










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



Step one: My prompt word for this Blob

# CONCLUSIONS



#### THE NUANCE OF MILITARY LIFE

- Diverse, complex and nuanced
- E.g. holding two ideas simultaneously
- Not simply 'good' or 'bad' be aware of binaries
- Identities as young people
- Consider the individual first and foremost
- Useful for a holistic approach

### AGENCY, NOT RESILIENCE

- Resilience = adult interpretation
- Focus on agency
- What service pupils do or could have control over
- Listen to their narratives
- Risks of 'resilience' label
- Empowerment, e.g. scaffolding choices




