Improve your skills to effectively support EAL learners, enabling pupils with little or no English to make rapid progress.

This 2 hour termly network is aimed at classroom teachers and teaching assistants in primary and secondary schools and practitioners in Early Years settings who support EAL learners and want to develop their understanding and skills. The number of EAL pupils in North Yorkshire (including refugees and asylum seekers) is increasing and outcomes for these learners are often not as strong as they could be. With effective early intervention and differentiated classroom support, these pupils can make rapid progress and achieve high outcomes.
