

Thriving Lives Innovation Fund (Pilot) 2023-24



Dear Headteacher/School Service Children Lead,

I am writing to you because your school has registered their use of the Thriving Lives Toolkit on the Service Children's Progression Alliance website. The SCiP Alliance is a partnership which builds enhanced support for the education and progression of young people in Armed Forces families, supported by the MOD. I am keen to let you know about an exciting opportunity to apply for a grant for your school from the Thriving Lives Innovation Fund (Pilot).

The aim of the programme is to:

- Help schools develop and test new approaches/interventions to improve the scale and/or quality of support for Service children
- Enhance collaboration between schools
- Capture case studies of effective practice to be shared with schools throughout the SCiP Alliance Community.

Grants of up to £20,000 can be sought to fund new, evidence-based approaches or interventions identified as a result of your Thriving Lives Toolkit self-assessment, to improve educational outcomes for children from Armed Forces families. This opportunity is only open to those we can contact on the Thriving Lives portal. It is a competitive grant fund so we encourage high quality applications, noting that the selection process will prioritise those working in collaboration between schools.

All applications must be received by the 5th June 2023. If your application is successful, you will receive confirmation by the 26th June. A Thriving Lives Toolkit self-assessment must be provided with your application.
