2.1 JD – Information updated on LiNCHigher website (The Future Focus). Call for any new updates to be sent to JD for promotion on website.

2.2 Discussed project suggestions in the last meeting. Call for any new ideas for SCiP Alliance projects to be brought to next meeting or directly to JD.







#### 3. Member's Development Updates

- 3.1 The chair opened discussion for any updates.
- 3.2 VP Discussed the MOD's AFF Strategy, recognising diversity of family, focusing on education and childcare. 10-year plan to drive forward change to support serving families. More details to come in following weeks which will inform plans better.
- 3.3 VP Thriving Lives Toolkit. Call for this to be showcased within more secondary schools across Lincolnshire, with such a high proportion of RAF bases and Service Children.
- 3.4 VP UCAS recently added identifier (tick box) to application forms for Service Children
- 3.5 VP April is the Month of the Military Child. For April 2023 there will be an increase in marketing to pull more attention to this. Noted Little Troopers workshops for education settings working with military children.
- 3.6 LT Noted April as the Month of the Military Child being a difficult month for schools to plan for with long school holidays.
- 3.7 AH Explained that April is chosen as a continuation of work done in America, popular usage of social media within this month for military families. Focus will move towards setting up activities during school holidays to supplement.
- 3.8 JD Call for possible ideas and projects to be brought to the next meeting.

#### 4. STEM Careers Event

- 4.1 JD Update that a move from a STEM Event at Scampton is now in plans for a weeklong STEM Event at RAF Cranwell. This is set to be the week commencing 14<sup>th</sup> November, the week beginning 7<sup>th</sup> November was also discussed as a back-up. This will take place primarily within the Education Centre which is a large premises.
- 4.2 JD [Shared document on screen] Run through of proposed plans for week, Future Focus on STEM, discussed the aims and format of the week.
- 4.3 JD to send out document.
- 4.4 Call for any feedback on proposed plan.
- 4.5 Plans for 1 day to focus on Primary Schools with content relevant to younger children. Split day with Morning session and Afternoon session with selected schools to cater for younger children also.
- 4.6 JD  $-2^{nd}$ ,  $3^{rd}$  and  $4^{th}$  day to be for Secondary schools from across Lincolnshire. Filled on a first come first served basis, aiming to have a high proportion of Service Children attending.
- 4.7 Final day to be opened to colleges. Already receiving interest from college groups.
- 4.8 LT Primary day to initially be targeted to Years 5 and 6, and possible expansion in coming years.
- 4.9 Red Arrows Pilot shown interest in attending, TBC.
- 4.10 VP To assist with contacts at Cranwell for STEM
- 4.11 JD Noted Ross Harrison (Pathways) will look into possible venues in East Midands area for expansion.
- 4.12 AP Mentioned Rolls Royce STEM activities. To share contact with JD and wider group.
