- Highly values the Alliance

To this end, the Group shall:

- Develop and manage the cycle of whole-system consultation, collaboration, planning, action and evaluation;
- Champion the vision and mission of the Alliance and operate in accordance with its values.

The membership of the Management Group must, therefore, reflect the diversity of the SCiP Alliance Community and the group's operating practices should demonstrate its:

- Diversity
- Inclusivity
- Collaboration
- Transparency
- Focus on Service children
