The evidence-based Thriving Lives toolkit explains the 7 principles of effective support for Service children in school and provides self-reflection questions linked to further guidance, case studies and resources. At this conference you will explore the principles, reflect on your practice and plan action back in school.

As partners of the SCiP Alliance we are all passionate about providing opportunities for individuals and communities to flourish. The aim of the event is to work with staff within schools and colleges across Lincolnshire and the East Midlands to raise aspirations and awareness of further and higher education. This FREE CPD series will bring together the perspective of practitioners and students from Armed Forces communities.

We are hosting a series of FREE Virtual CPD sessions to cater for secondary schools and colleges. The first session is an Introductory session to the Thriving Lives Toolkit taking place on Wednesday 10th November (10:00am – 12:00pm).

At this introductory session delivered by a member of the central SCiP Alliance team, staff will explore the principles, and associated new CPD resources, reflect on their practice and create a plan of action for their school. It will also cover the following themes:

- Understanding Service children's lives and how the Alliance helps
- How schools can use the Thriving Lives Toolkit to help Service children thrive
- Who can support schools to help Service children thrive, and how?

To follow on from the introductory session, a series of CPD sessions will take place over numerous weeks (dates below). We are looking for contributions for these 1-hour workshops.

- Session Three: Wednesday 1st December (16:00pm – 17:00pm)
- Session Four: Monday 6th December (16:00pm – 17:00pm)

This is not an extensive list, but we encourage contributions covering the following CPD workshop topic areas:

- Challenges faced by young people from Armed Forces families and how to support within the school environment.
- Pupil Premium – what is it and how can it be used.
- SENCO support – including EHCP, emotional and pastoral support for children moving schools
- Families Federation session
- FE/HE Level Up Outreach session including FE/HE cadet societies/programmes to support extracurricular activities and transition into HE.

- Bursaries and sponsorships available
- Subject/careers which are high priority to recruit individuals to e.g. Dentistry and Medicine within the tri services.

The deadline for submissions is Wednesday 8th September. We hope to let successful submissions know the week commencing 13th September - this will include confirmation of which date your session has been assigned to.
